




Between the Twilights: Being Studies of Indian Women by One of Themselves (Paperback)

The present volume consists of studies of Indian women. A passage on p. 32 affords a key to all that the book contains, where we read: The Hindu woman acknowledges no claims save those of religion. No social, no communal claims. Her worship of the gods, her husband, her children, they are all the same, part of her religion, and they make her life. Miss Sorabji devotes separate chapters to an Indian woman's relations to her gods, her husband, and her children. Her sketch of a religious woman in Chapter VI is good. Truth-named, in Chapter VII., is an example of the best type of an Indian holy man. The author excuses herself for introducing...
